



N.U.T. COUPONS and DRESS DOWN DAYS GUIDELINES

Dress code reminder for non-uniform/dress down days:

Non-uniform days are fun! But everyone must still dress in a manner that is respectful to teachers, staff, and students.

The following dress code details are from the St. Rita School Handbook:

- Student apparel must be school appropriate, even on a dress down day.
- Undergarments must not be visible above, below, or through clothing.
- Revealing clothing (including short shorts, halter tops, half shirts, and see-through tops) are not allowed.
- Leggings are allowed, provided that a top is worn that falls to the top of the thighs or lower.
- High heels, platform shoes, flip flops, open-toe sandals, crocs, and shoes with no back are not allowed.
- Clothing must not be torn, ragged, or have holes.

Please note the following:

Teachers and staff may determine that clothing not addressed above is not appropriate for school. If a student's apparel is deemed inappropriate, the student will be given a uniform to wear, and/or a parent/guardian may be called to bring a replacement for the inappropriate apparel. Students who violate dress code requirements on a NUT coupon day or Dress Down Day will forfeit NUT coupons and/or dress down privileges for the rest of the school year. No refunds will be given.
